

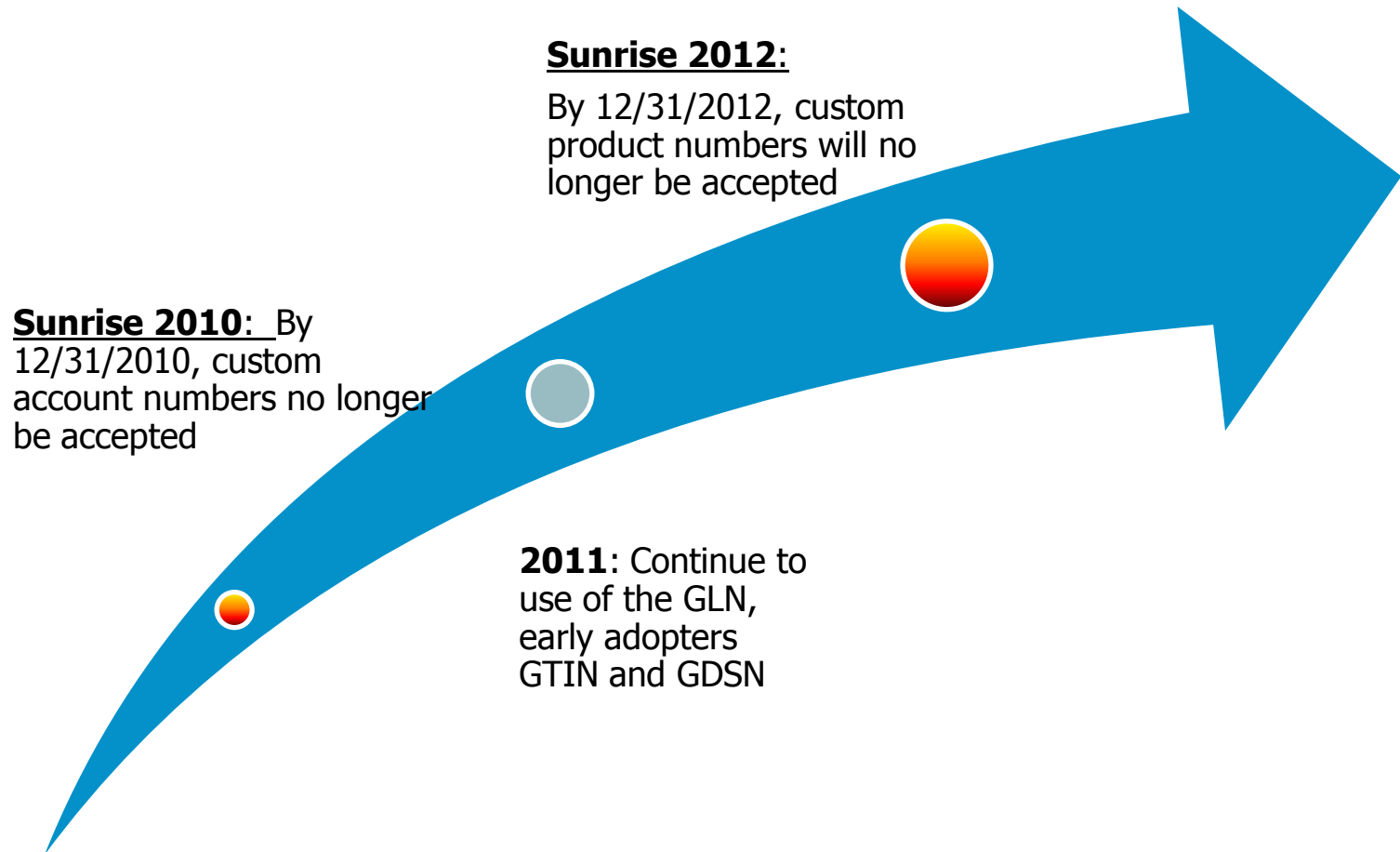

Provider Sunrise Definition

- Synchronize Locations
 - VHA Roster and GLN Registry for Healthcare
 - Own and maintain locations on the GLN Registry
 - GS1 Readiness Document
- Ready to Transact with GLN (replacing account number)
 - Electronic PO - EDI 850, maybe receive EDI 855, EDI 856, EDI 810
 - Manual Order (call in or fax) with a GLN
 - Sales reporting and rebates with a GLN
 - GLN's on LOP's/LOC's
- Solutions - MMIS System Readiness
 - Upgrade to the correct version
 - Apply a "patch"
 - Data Substitution (Lawson)
 - EDI Data Mapping - GHX
 - Modify the data stream

Supplier Sunrise Definitions

By December 31, 2010, custom account numbers will no longer be accepted. All manufacturers must use a GLN. Hospital members can order their products with a GLN and all sales reporting and rebates will be paid with a GLN

Monthly Net Sales Reports - all member entities reported must be identified using the GLN as of December 31, 2010.

Rebate reports must be provided - all member entities reported must be identified using the GLN as of December 31, 2010.

Member facilities and their tier assignments - all member entities reported must be identified using the GLN as of December 31, 2010.

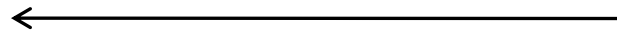
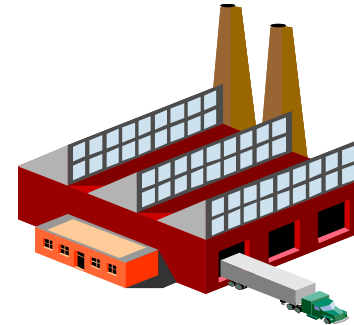
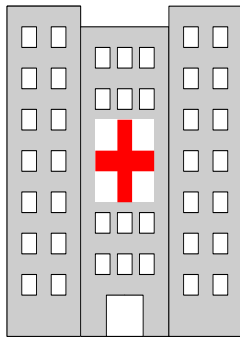
Letters of commitment (LOCs) or Letters of participation (LOPs) - all member entities reported must be identified using the GLN as of December 31, 2010.

Supplier Sunrise Definitions

- Supplier Expectations:
 - Receive electronic PO (EDI850) with either a single GLN or potentially a format that contains both the original account number as well as the GLN.
 - Process manual orders, phone or fax, that uses a GLN rather than account number.
 - Return an PO Acknowledgement (EDI 855) or Advance Ship Notice (EDI 856) with a GLN.
 - Receive an electronic Sales Tracing or Chargeback (EDI 867) from a distributor with a GLN.
 - All GPO fees and rebates are paid with a GLN and tiered pricing is managed with a GLN.

Ordering Process - Electronic PO to Supplier Using a GLN

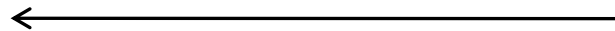
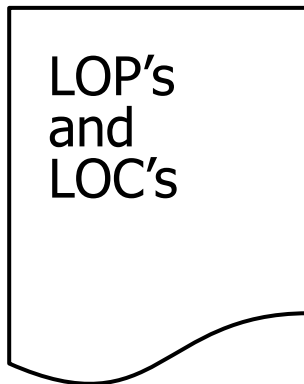


Rebate Goes to Hospital based on GLN
